



# Community-Led Pond Project in Baran District Offers Sustainable Solution to Water Scarcity

The newly constructed farm pond begins to collect water, paving the way for irrigation support and groundwater recharge

**Baran, Rajasthan, July 08, 2025:** In a significant stride toward water sustainability and rural resilience, a large community pond has been developed in Bhoyal village of Baran district, Rajasthan. The initiative, led by the social enterprise Grow-Trees.com with active support from local residents, aims to address the region's persistent water scarcity by harvesting rainwater for irrigation and groundwater recharge.

Constructed over 1.5 months from May to June 2025, the pond measures approximately 120 feet in length, 25 feet in width, and 8–10 feet in depth. With a capacity of over 700,000 litres (approximately 154,514 gallons), it is expected to support irrigation needs from July through December—crucial months for farming in a region that depends heavily on monsoon rains.

In addition to the pond, Grow-Trees.com has also initiated the Trees for Farmers® project in Shahbad tehsil of Baran. Of the targeted 90,000 trees, 25,700 have already been planted. The project is designed to supplement rural livelihoods through agroforestry and support long-term environmental restoration.

As communities across India seek climate-resilient solutions, Bhojal's success story underscores the importance of collaborative, grassroots-led water management initiatives in building sustainable rural futures.
