# **TURNING GREEN** THE **GIFTING SCENE**

Grow-Trees is redefining the card-giving culture into a green practice that makes the environment happy

hat would be a better gift to cherish and rejoice a life-long friendship than to gift something which is itself lifelong like a tree! Grow-Trees is one such social enterprise that enables individuals and corporates to greet their loved ones with trees in the form of eTreeCertificates at a nominal rate of 85 INR i.e. less than almost a dollar! Grow-Trees believes in breaking the cliches and reconstructing the whole card-gifting culture into a green practice which serves the biodiversity, water resources, pollution levels, and tribal communities

Grow-Trees was started in 2010

on the World Environment Day by Pradip Shah, the founder of India's first credit-rating agency, CRISIL. This was the point when climate change and concepts of sustainable development had started to gain popularity globally. In 1992, Shah, an MBA from Harvard Business School, discovered this "Greet with Trees" tradition in Israel where he had gone to provide his insights on establishing a credit rating agency. "India being such a huge economy should inculcate this tradition amongst individuals and companies to Greet with Trees - plant a real tree in public lands and dedicate it to greet employees/ customers/friends with an attractive

This decade-old organisation has planted close to 3.9 million trees across 16 states of India, thereby reducing carbon emissions each year by a massive 78,252,500 kg. Alongside reducing the carbon emission, it is working towards maintenance and restoration of wildlife species by planting native trees surrounding the buffer zones



### Trees for empowering communities

Since its inception, Grow-Trees believes that maintenance and restoration of natural ecosystems and their services are essential to sustained community well-being, economic prosperity, and efficiency. Grow-Trees has repeatedly demonstrated this through their tree projects with different social impact based projects, such as - Trees for Tribal, Trees for Elephant, Trees for Red Panda, Trees for Water, Trees for the Himalayas etc. They have been consistently operating in the tribal states of Jharkhand, Odisha, Chhattisgarh and rural areas of India to regenerate the depleted forest cover. The saplings are developed from seeds and the months preceding the plantation season are spent on nurturing them in nurseries. Local communities benefit exceedingly from these efforts in terms of livelihood, food, timber, and other non-timber returns. "We have been able to create approximately 323,909 days of employment in one of the most backward regions of the country where government and external interventions are lacking," emphasises Bikrant.

Aside from planters, Grow-Trees has more than 500 corporate partners who regularly honour their employees/customers/stakeholders through their customized eTreeCertificates and firmly believe in investing heavily in the realm of sustainability

so that both tribal communities and animals can meet their food, shelter and livelihood needs. Across the globe, policymakers, individuals and enterprises are trying to rebalance, restore and preserve the ecological balance that we were once endowed with. Striking efforts are being made by them to conserve rather than maximise species.

"We are driven to plant a million trees this monsoon, irrespective of any external help as our organisation is completely based upon selfsustainable approach," says Bikrant Tiwary, CEO of Grow-Trees.com.

### Trees for wildlife

According to WWF, 1 square kilometre of the forest may be home to more than 1,000 species. Grow-trees has been striving hard to protect the species with projects like Trees For Asian Elephants in Jharkhand, Trees For Sloth Bears, Trees For Indian Giant Flying Squirrels in Rajasthan, Trees For Tigers in Sunderbans amongst many others. Forest cover provides shelter and natural habitat for animals and therefore, it is relevant to reverse habitat fragmentation and save them by planting more trees.
